



## Certificate of Attendance FAQ:

### 1. How many hours can I claim?

The number of PD hours that can be claimed by each visitor for this event varies and you can only claim for the number of hours you attend the event. As an example:

- If you attended the event on Sunday between 11am – 3pm you can claim a maximum of 4 hours in total.
- If you attended the event on Saturday between 12pm – 3pm and Sunday between 10am – 1pm you can claim a total of 6 hours.

### 2. Which professional standards can I claim for?

The professional standards able to be claimed will be different for each visitor and depend on:

- Which exhibitors you have engaged with during your time at the event.
- The seminars and/or workshops you attended (if any).

### 3. How can I prove which exhibitors I have spoken with and which seminars & workshops I attended?

As outlined in emails prior to each events, we strongly suggest that you refer to the Visitor Guide and mark down which exhibitors you have spoken with and presentations attended. The Visitor Guide is also an excellent reference tool for use throughout the year.

The Guide can be attained prior to the event with your Australian Teacher Magazine subscription by delivery or online and is also given to you at the entrance of the expo. It can also be collected at the Certificate booth inside the hall. For verification purposes, we also keep a variety of records of each visitor who attended on each day.
